3. For those of you who are married, we know that God has made you one flesh with your spouse, but how have you seen the 'oneness' of your relationship grow over the years? For those of you who are not married, is there a couple you may look up to as an example of a marriage you can admire and why?
4. Pastor Brett read some very sobering words from Proverbs chapter 5. Open your Bibles to Proverbs 5. He also mentioned that Solomon spent a lot of time teaching his son about sexuality and warning of adultery. Was there anything that stuck out to you from Proverbs 5? Why do you think Solomon spoke so much about it and why is it so important to gain wisdom about these issues from Scripture?
5. As you think about the world we live in, what are some of the opposing messages to the Bible that we encounter surrounding marriage and sex?
