WELCOME (15 minutes)

• Ice Breaker: Has anything ever been stolen from you? Tell about it.

WORSHIP (10 minutes)

WORD (25 minutes)

- 1. In Genesis 27 we see the story of when Jacob stole the blessing from Esau. In this instance, Jacob chose to listen to his mother's voice instead of God's voice. In the same way, Eve chose to listen to Satan's voice instead of God's voice when she stole the forbidden fruit. Whose voices are we tempted to listen to and why do we often listen to other people's voices instead of God's voice?
- 2. Read Exodus 20:15. Stealing always involves a lie. For example, Jacob lied at least three times to Isaac when he stole the blessing. But most of the lies involved in stealing are lies that we tell ourselves to justify our acts. What lies do we tell ourselves and what is the corresponding truth?
- 3. Rebekah and Isaac gave Jacob his name which means "he who grabs the heel", which is a Hebrew idiom for "the deceiver". So, Jacob was labeled as a deceiver at birth, and once he started to believe that label his actions started to align. Most of us have received labels (good or bad) in our lives and many times those labels become our identity. Share how you've seen this come to life in your or others' lives.
- 4. Read James 2:10: Stealing always hurts people. Some examples are more obvious like the trail of hurt that Jacob left behind him when he stole the blessing. But some examples are less obvious like when you use office supplies at work for personal use. How does an understanding of the holiness of God and a proper view of why He died on the cross help us understand the magnitude of even the smallest of sins?

WORKS (25 minutes)
