

IN THE DUST OF THE RABBI

Review from last weekend:

“Salvation is free, but discipleship costs everything we have.”

If you are a disciple, you have committed your entire life to being like your Rabbi.

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last. (*John 15:16*)

Discipleship has a...

1. **CALL**

2. **COST**

3. **COMMITMENT**

Why? Because there is a **CAUSE** (*John 12:23-28*)

Yose ben Yoezer said to his disciples,
“Cover yourself in the dust of your rabbi’s feet.”

And so...

We look at a few of the specific areas where Jesus would have us “walk in His dust.”

1. Jesus hates **HYPOCRISY** (*Matthew 23:13, 15, 25-27, 29*)
2. Jesus calls us to personal **HOLINESS** (*1 Peter 1:13-16*)
3. Jesus **PRAYED** – passionately, desperately, miraculously (*John 17*)
4. Jesus lived out **GENEROSITY & SERVICE** (*John 13:12-17*)
5. Jesus lived out **INCARNATIONAL** ministry (*Luke 4:16-21*)

Brother’s Keeper Thought: Get with your spiritual partner and plan to take half a day (about 4 hours) to go to a secluded place together. Pray alone and together. Be silent before God. Spend extra time in the Scriptures. Write down those things God says to you and share them – then pray about those things together. Return to “life” refreshed.
