If you are a disciple, you have committed your entire life to being like your Rabbi.

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last. (John 15:16)

Discipleship has a...

1. CALL

2. **COST**

3. **COMMITMENT**

Why? Because there is a **CAUSE** (John 12:23-28)

Yose ben Yoezer said to his disciples,

"Cover yourself in the dust of your rabbi's feet."

And so...

We look at a few of the specific areas where Jesus would have us "walk in His dust."

- 1. Jesus hates <u>HYPOCRISY</u> (*Matthew 23:13, 15, 25-27, 29*)
- 2. Jesus calls us to personal HOLINESS (1 Peter 1:13-16)
- 3. Jesus <u>PRAYED</u> passionately, desperately, miraculously (*John* 17)
- 4. Jesus lived out **GENEROSITY & SERVICE** (John 13:12-17)
- 5. Jesus lived out **INCARNATIONAL** ministry (Luke 4:16-21)

Brother's Keeper Thought: Get with your spiritual partner and plan to take half a day (about 4 hours) to go to a secluded place together. Pray alone and together. Be silent before God. Spend extra time in the Scriptures. Write down those things God says to you and share them – then pray about those things together. Return to "life" refreshed.
