#### **WELCOME (15 minutes)**

- **Ice Breaker:** Tell about some sport or activity or thing you are really not very good at.

#### **WORSHIP (10 minutes)**

#### **WORD (25 minutes)**

1. Have someone read Proverbs 15:33. Talk about how real humility is necessary to truly fear and follow the Lord.
2. Read aloud Proverbs 16:18. Don said not only was the Egyptian Pharaoh’s country in ruin, his firstborn dead, and his fall colossal, but with pride and haughtiness as his guide, Pharaoh went right into the sea after Israel and thus entered his own watery grave! Talk about how our pride and arrogance often blind us.
3. Our culture preaches a gospel of self-serving, self-advancement where we take advance of people and put our desires and pleasures ahead of others – even our own families. In contrast, read Proverbs 8:13. What are ways you have used to hold back your prideful self-focus and instead be guided by humility?
4. If your primary concern is what the world thinks of you then pride is your guide! How do we instead learn to find our identity in who God says we are? Tell about where you are on the journey of genuinely learning this.

#### **WORKS (25 minutes)**

- Break down into smaller units of 2 or 3s to pray with each other!
