WELCOME (15 minutes)

WORD (25 minutes)

- 1. Was there a time when you came to understand there was a COSMIC REALITY going on behind what you could see that meant you needed to be redeemed and rescued from your sinfulness? If so, have a couple in the group tell about when and how that happened.
- 2. Read together Gen. 49:10; Isa. 7:14; and John 1:9-11. How do you think it possible that after thousands of years of looking for a promised Messiah that His people missed Him when He came? How are we/you ever guilty of holding to truths and promises but over time letting them get twisted to what we want?
- 3. Read Galatians 3:23-25. What was the purpose of the law of God if not to be our path to righteousness? How do we help people understand the path to righteousness is only through Jesus and not our efforts?
- 4. Read Galatians 4:1-5. Why is our adoption tied to "the fullness of time"? What do you think that phrase means?
- 5. Read Galatians 4:6-7. Have you ever had trouble accepting that you are a chosen and adopted child of God? Why do you think that is? How does accepting that we have been adopted move us into greater intimacy with God?
