

#2 LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR Mark 12:28-31

<u>Mark 12:28-31</u> One of the

scribes approached. When he heard them debating and saw that Jesus answered them well, he asked Him, "Which command is the most important of all?" ²⁹ "This is the most important," Jesus answered: Listen, Israel! The Lord our God, the Lord is One. ³⁰ Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. ³¹ "The second is: Love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other command greater than these."

LOVE YOUR <u>NEIGHBOR</u>

Luke 10:25-37 ... "And who is my neighbor?" ... ³⁶ "Which of these three do you think proved to be a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?" ³⁷ "The one who showed mercy to him," he said. Then Jesus told him, "Go and do the same."

I. BE <u>INTENTIONAL</u> IN BEING <u>JESUS</u> TO YOUR NEIGHBORS

John 1:14 The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighborhood. THE MESSAGE

John 1:14 And the Word (Christ) became flesh (human, incarnate) and tabernacled (fixed His tent of flesh, lived awhile) among us. AMPLIFIED BIBLE

<u>**1 Corinthians 12:27**</u> You are Christ's body—that's who you are! You must never forget this. THE MESSAGE

II. STRETCH OUT OF YOUR <u>COMFORT</u> <u>ZONE</u> TO LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR

Luke 15:1-2 ... "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them!"

Luke 7:34 ...'Look, a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners!'

Matthew 25:35-38 Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed by My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. ³⁵ For I was hungry and you gave Me something to eat; I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; ³⁶ I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you took care of Me; I was in prison and you visited Me.'

Matthew 25:37-39 "Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You something to drink? ³⁸ When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or without clothes and clothe You? ³⁹ When did we see You sick, or in prison, and visit You?'

<u>Matthew 25:40</u> "And the King will answer them, 'I assure you: Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.'

III. JOIN JESUS ON HIS MISSION

John 20:21 Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying: Who should I send? Who will go for Us? I said: Here I am. Send me.
