

# #2 Inconvenient Truths

## Review of Week 1...

### THE GOOD NEWS!

Rom. 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. <sup>17</sup>For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

The Gospel is powerful enough to save people!

The Gospel is effective for all who believe it!

The Gospel reveals the way to obtain righteousness - by faith!!!

## THE BAD NEWS

God's Wrath is **Real** and **Active** (1:18)

The Creator Holds Mankind Accountable for **Knowing Him** (1:19-20)

Mankind Continually, Foolishly Fails to Glorify God as God (1:21)

Mankind Continually, Foolishly Worships  $\underline{Idols}$  Instead of the True Eternal God (1:22-23)

God's Righteous Wrath is Revealed through Removal of His **Restraining Grace** (1:24-28)

Mankind Knowingly and Willingly Engages in all kinds of <u>Sins</u> against God, Self, and Others (1:29-32)

God's Wrath and Judgment Extend not only to Sin-Soaked '<u>Prodigals'</u> but also to Self-Righteous, Judgmental, Hypocritical '<u>Older Brothers</u>' (2:1-5)

All Mankind Stands Before their Creator Totally <u>Guilty</u> of Sin (3:9-12,19)

#### THE NOW EVEN BETTER GOOD NEWS!!!!!

<u>Rom. 3:21</u> But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. <sup>22</sup>This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference, <sup>23</sup>for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, <sup>24</sup>and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

- 1. God has made a right standing with Him possible through the marvelous plan of the Gospel
- 2. The Gospel declares that a right standing with God cannot be earned by law-keeping, but only through faith in Jesus Christ
- 3. This right standing is the result of being 'justified' by God, which is offered freely as a grace gift to all, no distinctions
- 4. This justification was purchased potentially for everyone by Jesus
- 5. The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross allows God to justify sinners while still remaining just Himself
- 6. Now God justly justifies ALL those who have true faith in His Son Jesus!

### Memory Verse:

<u>1Cor. 1:18</u> For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
