1. Where, or from whom, would you say you first learned how to pray?
2. What's one word you would use to describe your prayer life now? Explain.
3. Of all the descriptors of God that Jesus could have started the model prayer with (i.e. Our Creator, Our Provider, Our Rescuer, etc.), why do you think He chose "Father"? How does knowing God is your Father impact the way you approach Him in prayer?
4. What new understanding of God as Father has the Holy Spirit been impressing upon you from Steve's message or this time tonight? How can you apply that truth to your prayer life?

1. Welcome everyone - Check-in! *How's everyone doing?*
2. Make plans for any ministry or fun activities you'll be doing soon as a group!
3. Discuss the Small Group Discussion Questions.
