WORD (25 minutes)

- 1. Parenting is hard work! Kevin Durant's recent Most Valuable Player speech for the NBA gave credit to his Mom and all she did in raising him and his siblings as the real MVP in his life. How can we do better at honoring Mothers (our own and others) for all they do?
- 2. We honor our Moms by remembering their efforts at helping us to know God. Read aloud 2 Timothy 1:5 and 3:14-15. Talk about how much your Mom was or was not involved in you coming to know and love Jesus.
- 3. Read **Proverbs 6:20-21**. Talk about a Mother's (and Father's) responsibility to raise, instruct and shape their children. How can parents today actively seek to impact their children's heart? How can any of us better impact our children or the young minds we have influence over?
- **4.** Read **Proverbs 6:22**. How have your parents' (Mother or Father's) instructions actually guided, watched, or spoken to you?
- **5.** Read **John 19:25-27**. What does this action communication about Jesus as He is concerned for His Mother even as He endured the cross? What application might this have for YOU?

WORKS (25 minutes)

• Break down into 2 or 3's of the same gender & genuinely PRAY for each other.
