

## \#1 "Father, Forgive Them" Luke 23:33-36 (ESV)

## The Crucifixion of Jesus

Luke 23:33 And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. ${ }^{34}$ And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide his garments. ${ }^{35}$ And the people stood by, watching, but the rulersscoffed at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself, if he is the Christ of God, his Chosen One!" ${ }^{36}$ The soldiers also mocked him, coming up and offering him sour wine ${ }^{37}$ and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save yourself!"

## WHAT WAS GOING ON?

> A completely Innocent Man who had just been Unfairly Condemned in a Rigged Trial was suffering Inhumane Torture at the hands of Mocking People.

## WHAT DID HE SAY?

> "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do."
> He said what none of us would have said.

## WHY DOES IT MATTER ... FOR ME \& YOU?

$>$ Jesus is our Supreme Example of how to treat our own enemies.
> No sin is too evil to be forgiven by God!
> If there was forgiveness for these Jesus-hating Christ-killers, then God can forgive anybody for anything they have done!

## HOW DID JESUS NOT RESPOND?

$>$ He did not respond in the way that we might expect a person in that situation to respond.
> He did not say what many of us would have said.
