

## Humbling The Proud

**PSALM 25:4-5** 

Daniel 4:1-37 (NIV)

## God humbles the proud and exalts the humble.

- <u>NOBODY</u> is outside of the sovereign rule of God not even <u>PROUD</u>, powerful rulers
  - God controls all things and all people and He can change the heart of the hardest critic and most powerful authorities
  - God will stop at nothing to show His people that no one or nothing is outside of His sovereign control
- 2. God will **HUMBLE** the proud
  - o Pride **ELEVATES** our status and **LOWERS** God's status
  - "According to Christian teachers, the essential vice, the utmost evil, is Pride. Unchastity, anger, greed, drunkenness, and all that, are mere flea bites in comparison: it was through Pride that the devil became the devil: Pride leads to every other vice: it is the complete anti-God state of mind... it is Pride which has been the chief cause of misery in every nation and every family since the world began." - C.S. Lewis
  - Worldly pride is a belief in the lie of <u>SELF-SUFFICIENCY</u> and <u>SELF-RELIANCE</u>
  - Religious pride is the belief that you <u>EARNED</u> your standing with God
  - God is willing to bring you to the <u>END</u> of yourself so you can come to the <u>BEGINNING</u> of Him
    - It can't be Jesus **PLUS** anything

- 3. God will **EXALT** "The Humble"
  - o Biblical Humility is:
    - A tangible sense of **SUBORDINATION** to God
    - It asserts <u>TRUTH</u>, not to bolster ego, but as a service to Christ and love for your adversary
    - It knows it is dependent on **GRACE** for everything
    - It is TEACHABLE
  - o <u>James 4:10 (ESV)</u> Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you.
    - This exaltation is a SPIRITUAL exaltation
    - The Lord will clothe you in righteousness, He will draw near to you, He will give you comfort and peace, and He will prepare a place for you in His eternal house
  - God's perfect example was in the exaltation of <u>JESUS</u>, THE Humble One
    - Philippians 2: 5-9: In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; 7 rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! 9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name.
  - God gives us a choice: humble <u>YOURSELF</u> or allow God to humble you.
    - <u>1 Peter 5:6 (ESV)</u> Humble YOURSELVES, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you.
