10 For Thine Is The Kingdom

Matthew 6:9-13(KJV) After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. ¹⁰ Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. ¹¹ Give us this day our daily bread. ¹² And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. ¹³ And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: **For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen**

Let's Review

1. Our Father which art in heaven:
God is the **OMNIPOTENT ONE** but He's also our **GOOD, GOOD, FATHER.**
2. Hallowed be thy name:
Hallowing His name or **HONORING** His name is not just words; it's a **LIFESTYLE.**
3. Thy kingdom come:
With this phrase we're asking God to **MANIFEST HIS KINGDOM** on earth.
4. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven:
With this phrase, we're asking God to **ACCOMPLISH HIS WILL** on this earth.
5. Give us this day our daily bread:
Notice we ask God for **WHAT WE NEED**, not necessarily for **WHAT WE WANT.**
6. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors:
Daily we amass **DEBTS WE CANNOT PAY.**
7. And lead us not into temptation;
God doesn't **TEMPT** us, but He will lead us into **TEMPTATION.**

8. But deliver us from the evil one:
We need deliverance from **THE ENEMY, THE WORLD, THE FLESH.**

For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen
