

Jesus and the Samaritan Woman John 4 (NIV)

- 1. Jesus brings **HOPE** to the **HOPELESS**
 - **a.** Biblical hope is a confident expectation that God's promises will come true
 - **b.** The Samaritan woman was the definition of hopelessness UNTIL she met Jesus, the definition of hope
 - **c.** Jesus will go to the ends of the earth to give you hope if you are His
- 2. The hope of Jesus **SATISFIES** more than anything in this world
 - **a.** John 4:13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
 - b. You were made BY God FOR God, which is why the only thing that will satisfy is living out God's purpose for your life to glorify His name
- 3. The hope of Jesus **RADICALLY CHANGES** our lives
 - **a.** The Samaritan woman's checkered past was turned from a source of shame to a source of praise, and it became a testament to God's power through her!
 - **b.** <u>2 Corinthians 12:9</u> "But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me."

A Practical Guide to Finding Hope

- **STUDY** God's word
 - **Psalm 119:105** Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.
- REMEMBER God's faithfulness
 - o <u>Psalm 77:11</u> I will remember the deeds of the LORD; yes, I will remember your miracles of long ago.
- STIR each other up
 - hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to STIR UP one another to love and good works, for neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the day drawing near.
- These practices will help you focus on the "unseen" vs. the "seen", so that you can find your hope in God and His unseen purposes for your life
 - <u>2 Corinthians 4:18</u> So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.
- Hope is a person, and His name is Jesus
- And **BECAUSE HE LIVES**, you can face tomorrow
