<u>Matthew 28:18-20(ESV)</u> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Acts 1:1-12(ESV) In the first book, O Theophilus, I have dealt with all that Jesus began to do and teach, 2 until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. ³ He presented himself alive to them after his suffering by many proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. ⁴ And while staying with them he ordered them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father which, he said, "you heard from me; ⁵ for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." 6 So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, will you at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" ⁷ He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons that the Father has fixed by his own authority. 8 But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." ⁹ And when he had said these things, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him out of their sight. 10 And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, 11 and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." 12 Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey away.

The Seven Steps To God

Step 1 – There is **A GOD**.

Romans 1:20(ESV) For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

Step 2 – I am ACCOUNTABLE to God.

Romans 14:12(ESV) So then each of us will give account of himself to God.

Step 3 – I've missed GOD'S MARK.

Romans 3:23(ESV) For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Step 4 – My sin **SEPARATES ME FROM** God.

Romans 6:23(ESV) For the wages of sin is death but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Step 5 – Only Jesus **NEVER SINNED**; he was different.

<u>I John 3:5(ESV)</u> You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin.

Step 6 – Only Jesus **CAN RECONCILE ME** to God.

<u>John 14:6(ESV)</u> Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

<u>I Peter 3:18(ESV)</u> For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit.

Step 7 – I am willing **TO TRUST JESUS ALONE** to save me.
