- 2. What are **YOU** looking forward to?
- 3. Here's what I'm looking forward to:
 - a. He's coming again, and he could come **TONIGHT**!
 - b. I'm ultimately looking forward to **ETERNAL** heaven
 - where we'll dwell in the new <u>HEAVEN AND</u> <u>EARTH</u> in glorified, incorruptible <u>BODIES</u>.
 - <u>PLUS</u>...
 - c. I believe it's **FAR BETTER** than you think it is. (John 14:1-6)
