

Final Instructions 1 Thessalonians 5:12-28(NIV)

<u>1Thessalonians 5:12-28</u> Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to acknowledge those who work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and who admonish you. ¹³ Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other. ¹⁴ And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone. ¹⁵ Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else. ¹⁶ Rejoice always, ¹⁷ pray continually, ¹⁸ give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. ¹⁹ Do not quench the Spirit. ²⁰ Do not treat prophecies with contempt ²¹ but test them all; hold on to what is good, ²² reject every kind of evil. ²³ May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴ The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it. ²⁵ Brothers and sisters, pray for us. ²⁶ Greet all God's people with a holy kiss. ²⁷ I charge you before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers and sisters. ²⁸ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

Some of the believers had been given the gift of **<u>TEACHING</u>** some of **<u>PREACHING</u>**.

- **<u>RECOGNIZE</u>** their gifts and <u>**RESPECT**</u> them.
- Obey those whom <u>GOD HAS PROVIDED</u> to be your <u>SPIRITUAL GUIDES</u> and <u>ELDERS</u> in the faith.
- Be at **PEACE** among yourselves.
- We need to **GET ALONG** and **WORK TOGETHER**.
- We must employ the **<u>GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT</u>** to <u>**LIVE IN PEACE**</u> with each other.

Galatians 5:22-23 NIV But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Do not repay evil with evil to your enemy

- Kill them with KINDNESS
- React in a supernatural way <u>REFLECTING</u> our <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> with Jesus Christ.

Romans 12:17-20 NIV Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. ¹⁸ If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. ¹⁹ Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord. ²⁰ On the contrary: "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."

Traits or Habits of the Christian

- > JOYFULNESS
- > <u>PRAYERFULNESS</u>
- > <u>THANKFULNESS</u>
- Do not **<u>PUT OUT</u>** the Spirit's fire-do not stifle the <u>**SPIRIT'S WORK**</u> in our midst...whether in worship, church ministry or in an individual Christian.
- **EVALUATE** everything we hear or read by the only true and good standard **GOD'S WORD**.
- **HOLD ON** to the good, **REJECT** the evil.
- Paul Begins and ends this letter with God's **PEACE** and His **GRACE**.
- We are "triune beings" **SPIRIT**, **SOUL**, **BODY**, each part to be set aside for God's purposes.
- It is His will as we read in 1 Thessalonians 4:3 and in 4:7 that we are called to live **HOLY** lives.

We don't do it on our own. It is the work of **JESUS CHRIST**.

Philippians 1:6 NIV being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

• We are **<u>COMMANDED</u>** to read this <u>ALOUD</u> to all the brothers.

<u>Romans 10:17 KJV</u> So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

<u>Romans 1:16 (ESV)</u> For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes...



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
