Use Your Influence (6/27/2021)

What does God require from me?

Micah 6:6-8 (TNIV)

With what shall I come before the LORD and bow down before the exalted God? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old? Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousand rivers of olive oil? Shall I offer my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? He has shown all you people what is good. **And what does the LORD require of you?** To **act justly** and to **love mercy** and to **walk humbly with your God**.

Matthew 23:1-4 (ESV)

Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples, "The scribes and the Pharisees sit on Moses' seat, so do and observe whatever they tell you, <u>but not the works they do</u>. **For they preach, but do not practice.** They tie up heavy burdens, hard to bear, and lay them on people's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to move them with their finger.

23-24

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cumin, and <u>have neglected the weightier matters of the law:</u> **justice and mercy and faithfulness. These you ought to have done,** without neglecting the others. You blind guides, straining out a gnat and swallowing a came!!

Outward expressions of <u>LOVE</u>

Act Justly: right decisions according to God's <u>commands</u> Love Mercy: compassion and kindness for the <u>unworthy</u> Walk Humbly: faithful <u>submission</u> to the One who is worthy

> Your <u>Heart</u> is Important, Not Just Your <u>Action</u>

Religious Obligation vs. Grateful Love

Believe Better: Focus on the message of the <u>cross</u> (upward);
Breathe Better: see ourselves as new in light of <u>grace</u> (inward);
Behave Better: respond with a purpose for the <u>kingdom</u> (outward).

2 Corinthians 5:17-19

17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a **new creation.** The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. **All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation**; that is, in Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and **entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.**

- Reconciled us back to himself UPWARD
- We are a new creation INWARD
- Entrusting to us the message OUTWARD

20 **Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us.** <u>We implore you</u> on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

Relational Cash

Basic Rules:

- Relational Cash becomes Influence
- Earn Cash then Spend It (Implore)
