The Persistent, Unceasing Widow

Jesus' Parables: natural realm stories teaching spiritual realm truths about God's Kingdom, where Jesus is king.

"If you're going to move to Brazil, there are some things you should know because we do things differently here."

The Parable of the Persistent Widow

The setting: "Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that they should always pray and **NOT GIVE UP**." (v.1)

The parable: The story is super-simple.

- The unjust judge is **UNRIGHTEOUS** toward both God and man.
- The widow was desperate, persistent, UNCEASING.
- (Even) the unjust, unrighteous judge was eventually willing to act within his authority for her.

"And will not God give justice to his elect, WHO CRY TO HIM day and night? Will he delay long over them? I tell you, he will give justice to them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, WILL HE FIND FAITH on earth?" (vv.7-8)
