

#2 My Truth, Your
Truth... THE TRUTH!
2 Timothy 3:14-17

Can we really have confidence that the Bible is telling us the truth? YES!

The Bible:

- is the **GOD-BREATHED**, inspired Word of God.
- is without error in the original writings and is the
 FINAL AUTHORITY for life, faith, and the Church.
- is God's gracious self-disclosure to man, written by human authors as they were inspired and <u>CARRIED ALONG</u> by the Holy Spirit.
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:19-21

The Bible:

- is authoritative, clear, necessary, sufficient, trustworthy, and complete in its revelation of God's revealed truth REGARDING SALVATION.
- We should <u>RECEIVE</u> it that way into our hearts and minds, believing all that God's Word teaches,

- observing and obeying all that it requires, and trustfully hoping in all that it promises.
- 1 Thessalonians 2:13, Psalm 119

Jesus:

- came <u>TO FULFILL</u> God's written Word (the Law and the Prophets.)
- promised that the <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u> would be at work among His people, particularly through the disciples as they wrote the New Testament.
- Matthew 5:17-18, John 14:15-16 & 25-26, 16:12-15
