

Jesus - The Eternal Intercessor Hebrews 7 (ESV)

Recap: The Superiority of Jesus

- 1. Jesus is superior to <u>ANGELS</u> (messengers) A Gospel message that is greater than any message from angels John 11:23-26
- 2. Jesus is superior to <u>MOSES</u> (led to Promised Land) A better promised land awaits for the family of God Revelation 21: 1 4
- 3. Jesus is superior to <u>HIGH PRIESTS</u> (offer sacrifices) A perfect sacrifice based on who Jesus is and what He did

Background

The whole point of the Bible is to point people towards Jesus and the Old Testament often uses typology to do this.

Typology - A prophetic symbol in the Old Testament that **FORESHADOWS OR ILLUSTRATES** the person and work of Jesus in the New Testament

Example:

- Old Testament Type Lambs being slain Genesis 22:7-8, Exodus 12:1-6, Isaiah 53:7
- New Testament Work of Jesus John 1:9

Hebrews 7: 1-10 introduces us to Melchizedek as a **TYPE OF CHRIST** which is all centered around the idea of priesthood.

Importance of Levitical Priesthood

Connected people with God

- 1. In Latin, priest is pontifex, and it means **BRIDGE BUILDER** Ezekiel 44:23 24
- 2. Acted as a **MEDIATOR** between people and God Leviticus 8-10
- 3. Carried out ritual **SACRIFICES** as an atonement for sin Leviticus 17:1-7
- 4. There was a **PERPETUAL** need for the work of the priests

Priestly Order of Melchizedek - Hebrews 7:1 - 10 Melchizedek in Genesis 14:17 - 20

- 1. Melchizedek was a King and a Priest Genesis 14:18
 - Importance of Name and Title Hebrews 7:2
 - Melchizedek King of **RIGHTEOUSNESS** 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - ➤ His Kingdom is Salem which means **PEACE** Romans 5:1
 - No indication of his genealogy (beginning) or death (end)
 - No mother or father Hebrews 7: 3
 - Perfect ILLUSTRATION of Jesus Christ Revelation 21:6
- 2. Melchizedek blessed Abraham & Abraham tithed to Melchizedek v. Genesis 14:19 20
 - Demonstrated the GREATNESS of Melchizedek Hebrews 7: 4 10
 - "The patriarch gave a tenth of his spoils" v. 4
 - Levi priesthood had a commandment to take tithes v. 5
 - A man with no chronological or genealogical blessed Abraham v. 7 8

Priesthood of Aaron Hebrews 7: 11 - 21 Priesthood of Melchizedek

Strictly Judaistic	Universal - over Jews & Gentiles
Subjects to Kings	Was Royalty
Offered no permanent righteousness	Priesthood of Righteousness & Peace
Based on hereditary	Priesthood was personal
Limited time (ages 25 - 50)	Priesthood was forever

Why Is It Important That Jesus Is Our High Priest? Hebrews 7:22 - 27

- 1. No human can fulfill what God requires
 - Jesus is the <u>GUARANTOR</u> of a better covenant v. 22
 - Jesus holds his priesthood PERMANENTLY v. 24
 - > Jesus is the ultimate **SAVIOR** v. 25
 - Jesus always makes <u>INTERCESSION</u> on our behalf v. 25
 - Jesus is <u>FUNDAMENTALLY</u> holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted - v. 26
 - Jesus has no need for daily sacrifice because He made the <u>ONLY SACRIFICE</u> THAT MATTERS- v. 27
- 2. Impacts our Gospel-Shaped Identity 1 Peter 2: 9
 - We are a <u>ROYAL PRIESTHOOD</u> Believers are called to be both a king and a priest, just as Jesus is both the King of kings and our forever High Priest
 - Are you a bridge builder for Christ? Are you intentionally connecting others to Jesus?

Only One Response - Jesus is Lord. I Will Follow You.

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
