

## “WHAT IS GOD’S WILL FOR MY LIFE?”

### **SAVED: Repenting and Trusting in Christ before it’s Too Late**

*II Peter 3:9 (KJV) The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering toward us, **not willing that any should perish**, but that all should come to repentance. 10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night...*

### **SANCTIFIED: Abstaining from Sexual Immorality**

*I Thessalonians 4:2 For you know what instructions we gave you through the Lord Jesus. 3 For **this is the will of God**, your sanctification: that you abstain from sexual immorality; 4 that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor, 5 not in the passion of lust like the Gentiles who do not know God...*

### **SPIRIT-FILLED: Constantly Yielding Control to The Holy Spirit**

*Ephesians 5:17 Therefore do not be foolish, but **understand what the will of the Lord is**. 18 And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit...*

### **SUBMITTED: Remaining Under Human Authority**

*I Peter 2:13 Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, 14 or to governors as sent by him to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. 15 For **this is the will of God**, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people.*

### **SUFFERING: Accepting Unfair Treatment Just Like Jesus**

*I Peter 3:17 For it is better to suffer for doing good, **if that should be God's will**, than for doing evil. 18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous...*

*I Peter 4:19 Therefore let those who **suffer according to God's will** entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.*

### **SAYING THANKS: Being Grateful Regardless of the Situation**

*I Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in all circumstances; for **this is the will of God** in Christ Jesus for you.*
