And as he sowed, **some fell along the path and was trampled underfoot, and the birds of the air devoured it.** ⁶And some **fell on the rock, and as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture.** ⁷And some **fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up with it and choked it.** ⁸And some **fell into good soil and grew and yielded a hundredfold.”** As he said these things, he called out, “He who has ears to hear, let him hear.”
