**1 John 3:16 (NIV)** This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us.

**1 John 3:1** See what kind of love the Father has given to us, that we should be called children of God; and so we are.

#### 5. Ultimately Satisfying In Its EXPERIENCE

**Psalms 34:8** Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good!

**Romans 5:5** ...God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

#### 6. Uncontainable In Its EXPRESSION

**1 John 4:7** Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. <sup>8</sup> Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love.

**1 John 4:19** We love because he first loved us.

#### 7. Unstoppable In Its DETERMINATION

**Romans 8:38** For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.
