

#3: God's Rescue Mission

The Parable Of The Tenants

Matthew 21:33-39 (NIV) "Listen to another parable: There was a landowner who planted a vineyard. He put a wall around it, dug a winepress in it and built a watchtower. Then he rented the vineyard to some farmers and moved to another place. "When the harvest time approached, he sent his servants to the tenants to collect his fruit. "5" "The tenants seized his servants; they beat one, killed another, and stoned a third. "6" Then he sent other servants to them, more than the first time, and the tenants treated them the same way. "7" Last of all, he sent his son to them. "They will respect my son," he said. "8" "But when the tenants saw the son, they said to each other, "This is the heir. Come, let's kill him and take his inheritance." "3" So they took him and threw him out of the vineyard and killed him."

The vineyard = **ISRAEL**

The landowner = **GOD THE FATHER**

The tenant farmers = THE JEWISH RELIGIOUS LEADERS

The servants = **GOD'S PROPHETS**

The landowner's son = **JESUS**

<u>Matthew 21:45-46 (NIV)</u> When the chief priests and the Pharisees heard Jesus' parables, they knew he was talking about them. ⁴⁶They looked for a way to arrest him, but they were afraid of the crowd because the people held that he was a prophet.

<u>Matthew 21:40-41 (NIV)</u> "Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those tenants?" ⁴¹"He will bring those wretches to a wretched end," they replied, "and he will rent the vineyard to other tenants, who will give him his share of the crop at harvest time.

1. GOD Doesn't THINK Like We Do

<u>Isaiah 55:8-9 (NIV)</u> "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. ⁹ "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts".

<u>1 John 4:7-9 (NIV)</u> Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. ⁸Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. ⁹This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.

2. **JESUS** Is The Rejected **CORNERSTONE**

<u>Matthew 21:42-44 (NIV)</u> Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: "'The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes'? ⁴³"Therefore I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit. ⁴⁴Anyone who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces; anyone on whom it falls will be crushed."

3. God Sent His SON To SAVE THE WORLD

John 3:16 (NIV) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

2 Peter 3:9 (NIV) The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

1 John 4:10 (NIV) This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.
