



#2 Jesus-Centered Parenting

1. Jesus centered parenting means **ACCEPTING** your kids for who they are *rather than* **USING** them to fuel your own fulfillment.

Ephesians 6:1-4 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ²“Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise—³“so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.” ⁴Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

2. Jesus-centered parenting involves **SPENDING TIME** on your kids

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. ⁷Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. ⁸Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. ⁹Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

3. Jesus-centered parents are **most** concerned about their children’s **CHARACTER & HEART**

Proverbs 22:15 Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline will drive it far away.

4. Jesus-centered parents know that **SHOW & TELL** is the only way to teach our kids
