

# **#3 Where is He Taking Us?**

## 1. Become a disciple of Jesus Christ

#### A. A clear CALL

<u>Matthew 9:9</u> As Jesus passed on from there, he saw a man called Matthew sitting at the tax booth, and he said to him, "Follow me." And he rose and followed him.

<u>John 1:43</u> The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, "Follow me."

#### B. A high **BAR**

Mark 8:34 And calling the crowd to him with his disciples, he said to them, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. <sup>35</sup>For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and the gospel's will save it.

Luke 14:25 Now great crowds accompanied him, and he turned and said to them, <sup>26</sup>"If anyone comes to me and does not hate his own father and mother and wife and children and brothers and sisters, yes, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. <sup>27</sup>Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple.

### C. Count the COST!

Disciples are believers who increasingly treasure Jesus and His Gospel *above all else*.

## 2. Help others become disciples of Jesus Christ

<u>Matthew 28:18</u> And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup>Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

# 3. Remember where others are coming from

Praying for Lost Prodigals	Praying for Lost Pharisees	
Ask The Father to parent them and to help you not become bitter	Pray that they will hear this story	
Pray for the grace to let them go and a willingness to endure for as long as it takes	Pray that God will orchestrate incidents that prompt self-reflection	
Pray for 'famine' to come to them	Pray that God will expose their self-righteousness and puncture their pride	
Pray for holy hunger and holy homesickness to invade their soul	Pray that the Spirit will open their eyes to see that their 'good behavior' isn't good enough for God	
Pray they would come to their senses and be given the gift of repentance	Pray that they will understand what they really deserve and their need for Jesus	
Pray they will be granted the ability to receive the grace of God	Pray that they will admit that they are as lost as prodigals	
Pray for 'welcoming love' and the Lord to pour out His riches when they return	Pray that they will feel the Father's love and hear Him summoning them home
