## How can we begin to see Jesus in the Old Testament?

1. **READ ABOUT AND STUDY** Jesus in the New Testament **FIRST**.

2.	Look for times where the New Testament REFERS TO OR QUOTES the Old Testament.
	"it is written"

## When Studying the Old Testament Ask Yourself...

1. How is this **CHARACTER** like or unlike Jesus and how is Jesus a **BETTER VERSION?** 

2. Does the <u>THING</u> you are reading about <u>REPRESENT OR</u> <u>FORESHADOW</u> Jesus?

3. Does the **STORY** you are reading **REMIND** you of Jesus in any way?
