

# #5 The First Christian Sermon – Part 1 Acts 2:14-21 (ESV)

#### PETER'S EXPLANATION OF PENTECOST

<u>Acts 2:14</u> But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them: "Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words. <sup>15</sup> For these people are not drunk, as you suppose, since it is only the third hour of the day. <sup>16</sup> But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel:

<sup>17</sup> "And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; <sup>18</sup>even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy. <sup>19</sup> And I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and vapor of smoke; <sup>20</sup>the sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the day of the Lord comes, the great and magnificent day. <sup>21</sup> And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.'

### 1. An Emphatic Denial 2:14-15

Common Cultural Narratives...

- Events of 2,000 years ago matter very little for our lives now.
- History is just moving along randomly; it is not "headed" anywhere in particular.
- If the Bible is true, then the God of Christianity must be a barbaric, racist, sexist misogynist.
- This idea Christians have that everyone will have to face a coming "judgment" by God is a laughable, archaic, outdated notion.
- "Salvation" if such a thing even exists should be understood in terms of individual achievement and self-actualization, not deliverance from divine judgment. That's repugnant!

## WHAT PENTECOST MEANS

### 1. It Means That <u>PROPHECY</u> Has Been Fulfilled – 2:16-18

### 2. It Means That "THE LAST DAYS" Have Begun – 2:19-20

- A. "The Last Days" is a span of time in God's Grand Plan that was inaugurated generally with the first coming of Christ, and specifically when Christ sent His Spirit on the Day of Pentecost.
- B. "The Last Days" Ends with a season of Supernatural Signs and Cosmic Wonders that signal to humanity that Christ is about to return and that "The Day of the Lord" judgment is drawing near.
  - ... "Preterist" view
  - ... "Futurist" view
  - ... "Dual-Fulfillment" view
- 3. It Means That The Gospel Is Now Freely Offered, And The Risen And Ascended Jesus Will <u>SAVE</u> All Who Believe – 2:21

<u>Acts 2:21</u> 'And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.'

**John 3:17** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

<u>John 5:24</u> Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.
