

#19 A World-Changing Vision

Acts 10:1-48 (NIV)

PREPARATION: Acts 1-9

- Cornelius and Peter were both <u>PRAYING</u> when God gave them a vision.
- The Holy Spirit is <u>DIRECTING</u> the spread of the Gospel.
 - It seems it is harder to prepare the one who is going to WITNESS than it is to prepare the one who is going to HEAR.

The Vision: Acts 9-20

- The sheet lowered by its four corners from heaven may represent the four corners for the **EARTH**.
- The sheet may be more like a net that gathers <u>BELIEVERS</u> into the kingdom.
- More than just Jesus' teaching; <u>Mark 7:17-20 (NIV)</u> "all foods clean"
- All people **NEED TO HEAR** the Gospel; we cannot pick and choose.

<u>Galations 3:28 (NIV)</u> There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

Action: Acts 21-48

- There are people <u>KNOCKING</u> at the gate.
- We must go out even to those we formerly **DISDAINED**.
- Peter shares the Gospel in Vs 39, 40 and 43
 - Jesus <u>DIED</u> (that we may have life)
 - o God **RAISED** Him from the dead on the third day
 - Everyone who <u>BELIEVES</u> in Him receives forgiveness of sin through His name
- People are saved only <u>AFTER</u> hearing the Gospel
- This is the message we **MUST SHARE**, no matter what else we may do
- This is the great **CALLING** of the church.

<u>Mark 16:15 (NIV)</u> He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

To be successful we must work by direction of the HOLY SPIRIT.
