PETER #4 Living in Light of the Lord's Return 2 Peter 3:1-18

1. Some people need to be <u>CONSTANTLY REMINDED</u> of things they already know

<u>2 Peter 3:1</u> This is now the second letter that I am writing to you, beloved. In both of them I am stirring up your sincere mind by way of reminder, ² that you should remember the predictions of the holy prophets and the commandment of the Lord and Savior through your apostles...

2. Some people <u>CAST DOUBT</u> on the Second Coming of Christ and the Future Judgment

<u>2 Peter 3:3</u> ...knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. ⁴ They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."

3. Some people <u>CONVENIENTLY OVERLOOK</u> how God has indeed intervened in the world in times past

<u>2 Peter 3:5</u> For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of God, ⁶ and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished.

4. Some people ought to be <u>COMPLETELY TERRIFIED</u> of God's impending judgment when Christ does return

<u>2 Peter 3:7</u> But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

5. Some people <u>CLEARLY MISINTERPRET</u> God's intent in "delaying" Christ's Return for so long

<u>2 Peter 3:8</u> But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. ⁹ The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. ¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.

6. Some people understand that the end of the age will signal the end of great opportunity, so they <u>CONSCIOUSLY COMMIT</u> to living in light of the Lord's Imminent Return throughout their remaining days <u>2 Peter 3:11-18</u>

FIVE CHALLENGES to God's People for Living in Light of the Lord's Imminent Return

- #1: **GODLY** *LIVING!* Live lives of godliness that reflect the character of The One Who is Coming for Us *3:11*
- #2: **EAGER** ANTICIPATION! Look forward with great hope to seeing Jesus face-to-face one day, when this world will be judged and righteousness will prevail in a new creation 3:12-13
- #3: **PURITY AND PEACE.** Strive to be free from contamination by this present world, pursuing holiness and harmony instead *3:14*
- #4: **EVANGELISTIC** <u>ZEAL</u>! Seize opportunities to bring the message of salvation to those who don't yet know the Lord, while there is still time *3:15-16*
- #5: **DISCERNING** AND DEVELOPING! Remain stable in the faith by (a) recognizing false teachers and resisting their influence, and (b) intentionally growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus 3:17-18
