

## #12 WATCH!!!

Ecclesiastes 10:1-20 (ESV)

A STUDY OF ECCLESIASTES

**Ecclesiastes 10:1** Dead flies make the perfumer's ointment give off a stench; so a little folly outweighs wisdom and honor. <sup>2</sup>A wise man's heart inclines him to the right, but a fool's heart to the left. <sup>3</sup> Even when the fool walks on the road, he lacks sense, and he says to everyone that he is a fool. <sup>4</sup>If the anger of the ruler rises against you, do not leave your place, for calmness will lay great offenses to rest. <sup>5</sup>There is an evil that I have seen under the sun, as it were an error proceeding from the ruler: 6 folly is set in many high places, and the rich sit in a low place. 7 I have seen slaves on horses, and princes walking on the ground like slaves. 8He who digs a pit will fall into it, and a serpent will bite him who breaks through a wall. <sup>9</sup>He who quarries stones is hurt by them, and he who splits logs is endangered by them. <sup>10</sup> If the iron is blunt, and one does not sharpen the edge, he must use more strength, but wisdom helps one to succeed. <sup>11</sup>If the serpent bites before it is charmed, there is no advantage to the charmer. <sup>12</sup> The words of a wise man's mouth win him favor, but the lips of a fool consume him. 13 The beginning of the words of his mouth is foolishness, and the end of his talk is evil madness. 14 A fool multiplies words, though no man knows what is to be, and who can tell him what will be after him? 15 The toil of a fool wearies him, for he does not know the way to the city. 16 Woe to you, O land, when your king is a child, and your princes feast in the morning! 17 Happy are you, O land, when your king is the son of the nobility, and your princes feast at the proper time, for strength, and not for drunkenness! <sup>18</sup>Through sloth the roof sinks in, and through indolence the house leaks. <sup>19</sup> Bread is made for laughter, and wine gladdens life, and money answers everything. <sup>20</sup> Even in your thoughts, do not curse the king, nor in your bedroom curse the rich, for a bird of the air will carry your voice, or some winged creature tell the matter.
