## Father's Day 2018

**Exodus 20:12 (NIV)** "Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

**Luke 18:20 (NIV)** You know the commandments: 'You shall not commit adultery, you shall not murder, you shall not steal, you shall not give false testimony, **honor your father and mother**.'"

**Ephesians 6:1-3 (NIV)** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> "**Honor** your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— <sup>3</sup> "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

### Several Ways We Can ALL Seek To Honor Our Fathers As Adults:

#### 1. FORGIVE them

**Luke 23:33-34 (NIV)** When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals—one on his right, the other on his left. <sup>34</sup> Jesus said, **"Father, <u>forgive</u> them, for they do not know what they are doing."**...

#### 2. SPEAK WELL of them

#### 3. Seek their INPUT AND WISDOM

**Proverbs 20:29 (NIV)** The glory of young men is their strength, gray hair the splendor of the old.

**Job 12:12 (NIV)** Is not wisdom found among the aged? Does not long life bring understanding?

**<u>Proverbs 4:1 (NIV)</u>** Listen, my sons, to a father's instruction; pay attention and gain understanding.

#### 4. <u>STAY INVOLVED</u> in their lives!

**<u>Psalm 71:9 (NIV)</u>** Do not cast me away when I am old; do not forsake me when my strength is gone.

**<u>1 Timothy 5:8 (NIV)</u>** Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

#### 5. Treat them with <u>RESPECT</u> and <u>CONSIDERATION</u>
