The Story of the Bible

1. The Bible is not **ABOUT US**; it's all about **JESUS**.

The Great Cloud of Witnesses

1. The story of **ABRAHAM** sacrificing **ISAAC**.

Hebrews 11:17-19

Jesus Debates with the Pharisees

- 1. Jesus confronts the Pharisees and it turns into a "**WHO'S YOUR DADDY" DEBATE**.
- 2. Jesus declares **<u>HIMSELF GOD</u>** by taking the identity of <u>**I AM**</u>.

3. Jesus validates ABRAHAM.

John 8:50–58 Yet I do not seek my own glory; there is One who seeks it, and he is the judge. ⁵¹ Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death." ⁵² The Jews said to him, "Now we know that you have a demon! Abraham died, as did the prophets, yet you say, 'If anyone keeps my word, he will never taste death.' ⁵³ Are you greater than our father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died! Who do you make yourself out to be?" ⁵⁴ Jesus answered, "If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me, of whom you say, 'He is our God.' ⁵⁵ But you have not known him. I know him. If I were to say that I do not know him, I would be a liar like you, but I do know him and I keep his word. ⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced that he would see my day. He saw it and was glad." ⁵⁷ So the Jews said to him, "You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?" ⁵⁸ Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am."

The Gospel in Genesis 22

- 1. God tells Abraham to **SACRIFICE** his **ONLY SON**.
- 2. They arrive at the spot God chooses **ON THE THIRD DAY**.
 - a. "Saw the place from afar" could be translated: **ENVISIONED THE SPOT IN THE FAR-OFF FUTURE**.
- 3. How old was **THE BOY**?
 - a. Abraham <u>LAID ON ISAAC</u> the wood for the altar and the <u>TWO OF</u> <u>THEM TOGETHER</u> walked up the hill.
 - b. Abraham answered the question by saying **GOD WILL PROVIDE HIMSELF** a lamb for the burnt offering.
- Abraham calls the place <u>JEHOVAH-JIREH</u> or in other words, <u>GOD</u> <u>WILL PROVIDE</u>.
- 5. Abraham returns **<u>BY HIMSELF</u>**; where's **<u>ISAAC</u>**?
 - a. We don't see Isaac again until **<u>HE MEETS HIS BRIDE</u>**.
