## IN THE #2 God's Design For BEGINNING A STUDY OF GENESIS 1-3 BEGINNING Genesis 2 (NIV)

- Genesis 2 is a **DETAILED DESCRIPTION** of the 6th day of creation.
- Genesis 2 is a snapshot of God's <u>DESIGN</u> for men and women, sex and marriage <u>BEFORE</u> sin entered the world.
- Genesis 2 takes place in a <u>PARADISE</u> God created for mankind in the Garden of Eden, a protected garden planted with everything man needed that was both <u>BEAUTIFUL AND DELIGHTFUL</u>.
- The Bible both **<u>BEGINS</u>** and <u>**ENDS**</u> with a marriage.
- The natural place to begin an investigation into what God thinks about marriage (and sex) is in Genesis 1 and 2, where scripture describes God's creation of the world and everything in it.

## Nine Truths About God's Design For Sex And Marriage From Genesis 1-2

- 1. Sex and marriage are a **<u>CREATION</u>** of God.
- 2. People are created as <u>GENDERED</u> beings. God intentionally made human beings male and female (*Genesis 1:27-28*)
- 3. The biblical design for marriage is **MONOGAMY**.
- **4.** The two sexes are equal in <u>VALUE</u>. "Equal but different" *(Genesis 1:27)*
- **5.** Marriage is an exclusive **<u>RELATIONSHIP</u>**. "Forsake all others" (*Ephesians 5:24-27*)

- **6.** Marriage is meant to be **PERMANENT**. Jesus affirmed the intended permanence for marriage. (*Matthew 19:3-6*)
- 7. Marriage is <u>HETEROSEXUAL</u>. "The man leaves his *father* and *mother* and clings to his *wife*." (*Mark 10:6-9, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10, Romans 1:26-27, 1 Timothy 1:9-10, Leviticus 20:13*)
- 8. One of the primary purposes of sex and marriage is <u>PROCREATION</u>."Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth." (*Genesis 1:28, 9:1, 35:11*)
- 9. Sex is good and beautiful. (Genesis 1:31 and 2:25)
- Marriage **MODELED** by Christ and the Church (*Ephesians 5:22-32*)

## Are We Living A Life That Imitates The Example Of Christ?

**Titus 3:3-7 NIV** At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.<sup>4</sup> But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, <sup>5</sup> he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.
