



## #3 Jesus, The Good Shepherd *John 10:1-21 (ESV)*

1. There are shepherds and then there are **THIEVES**
  - a. How to recognize a shepherd
  - b. How to recognize thieves or false shepherds (the Pharisees)
2. I AM... the **DOOR**
  - a. All other doors lead nowhere, but I AM the way to safety and pasture
  - b. The thief comes to steal, kill and destroy
  - c. Jesus comes that we may have life and have it abundantly
3. I AM... **THE GOOD SHEPHERD**
  - a. The Good Shepherd puts His life on the line to save His sheep
  - b. False shepherds, by contrast are primarily self-interested
  - c. I know my own and my own know me (just like the Father and the Son)

4. One **FLOCK**, one shepherd
  - a. Other sheep not of this fold
  - b. I must bring them also and they will listen to my voice
  - c. I lay down my life of my own accord for my sheep and I take it up again
5. Why **LISTEN TO** Jesus?
  - a. They accuse Him of having a demon and being insane
  - b. Look at the results of his ministry
6. What can we **LEARN** from all of this?
  - a. Beware of false shepherds
  - b. Don't be a false shepherd
  - c. We can truly trust in Jesus, the Good Shepherd, for everything
