Read John 12:12-19

1. When you think of Jesus as a King, how does that help shape your relationship to Him?
2. The Pharisees had some issues with Jesus. They believed that Jesus would ruin their kingdom. They were jealous of his popularity. They believed he and his way of living would infringe on their way of life. They didn't like the people he hung out with, Jesus didn't do spiritual things the way they wanted him to do them and many other things. How can you see yourself at times being like the Pharisees and how do we keep from becoming like the Pharisees?
3. In Pastor Brett' sermon, twice we were told that some of the Jews went out and told other people about Jesus. They bore witness to him. In your own life and sphere of influence, how can you begin to bear witness about Jesus more and more?
4. There are 4 accounts (in Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on the donkey. In Matthew's account, Jesus tells his disciples to go get it and in Matthew 21:6 we are told, "The disciples went and did as Jesus had directed them." A key aspect of being a disciple of Jesus is obedience. Jesus himself said in Matthew 28:19,20 that a disciple is taught to obey all that Jesus commands. As a group, try to think about and come up with some commands Jesus gave his followers and consider how you can begin to live in greater obedience to King Jesus.
