1. Read 1 Peter 2:15. What are ways that believers can “do good” that may lead toward silencing the foolish? (What are some ways that our small group could “do good” together?)
2. Read 1 Peter 2:16. If you were being honest, what are some ways that you may have abused your freedom in a way to excuse bad behavior? How might you live for God in that situation instead?
3. Read 1 Peter 2:21-23. Christ did not give a sharp reply when he suffered even though He was innocent. How challenging is it for you not to lash out at others, either out loud or in your mind?
4. Read 1 Peter 2:24-25. We have been healed by the blood of Jesus. Spend some time sharing praises out loud as a group!

1. Welcome everyone
2. Check-in with everyone. How’s everyone doing?
3. Make plans for any ministry or fun activities you’ll be doing soon as a group!
4. Discuss the Small Group Discussion Questions.
