- 2. Read 1 Peter 2:16. If you were being honest, what are some ways that you may have abused your freedom in a way to excuse bad behavior? How might you live for God in that situation instead?
- 3. Read 1 Peter 2:21-23. Christ did not give a sharp reply when he suffered even though He was innocent. How challenging is it for you not to lash out at others, either out loud or in your mind?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 2:24-25. We have been healed by the blood of Jesus. Spend some time sharing praises out loud as a group!
