WELCOME (15 minutes)

• Ice Breaker: Have you ever traveled to a place where you did not speak the native language? If so, where? What was your experience like as you tried to do basic things, such as order food or find a desired destination?

WORSHIP (10 minutes)

WORD (25 minutes)

- 1. Have everyone turn to 1 Peter 1 and somebody read aloud vs 1-2. The "Sojourners" is a word to describe someone who is journeying through this world as a temporary resident. Do you live as a stranger in this world, or as someone who is far too comfortable? How should your relationship with the world change if it truly isn't your home?
- 2. Read aloud vs 3-9. What does it mean to have received a living hope, and how did Jesus' resurrection deliver it to us? How should we live now in light of this hope? How does our new birth enable to us to live in any circumstance with joy and hope?
- 3. Read vs 10-12. What do we know about the salvation Peter spoke of in verse 10? What did Peter say these prophets searched and inquired carefully for? Why do you think Christians in Asia Minor needed this reminder? Why do we need this reminder?
- 4. How does our devotion to God's Word make us seem strange to the culture we live in? How does feeling strange and out of place drive us to our mission?

WORKS (25 minutes)

• Break down into smaller units of 2 or 3s to pray with and for each other!
