**WELCOME (15 minutes)**

1. Read vs 10. The theme of this verse seems to capture the focus of the entire book of 1 Peter – God is the source of our hope in the midst of suffering! What have been any main takeaways for you from our campaign through the book of 1 Peter? What are ways in the past couple of months you have become stronger, firmer, or more steadfast?
2. Read vs 1-6. What do you think is the relationship between willing submission to spiritual leaders and showing humility to one another? Is one of these more difficult for you than the other? Explain.
3. Read vs 7. What specific anxiety or concern do you need to cast humbly on the Lord?
4. Read vs 8-9. Do you think people tend to ignore the reality of the devil? Or, do they fear him too much? How does this passage help us to find a balanced approach to dealing with the devil?

**WORKS (25 minutes)**
