WELCOME (15 minutes)

WORD (25 minutes)

1. Read aloud Exodus 20:1-17 and talk about Christopher Hitchens’ claim that God created humans sick (covetous, murderous, disrespectful, lying, and adulterous) and then command us to be well! How is this a misunderstanding of the 10 Commandments?
2. Read Matthew 22:35-40 and respond to this quote: “If your heart is being transformed into the kind of heart God desires for you - full of deep, passionate love for God and an indiscriminate love for people - then you’ll actually end up keeping all Ten Commandments.” How are you seeing God transform your heart recently?
3. Read Romans 3:10-11 & James 2:10 and respond to this statement: “Never are humans more inclined to overrate themselves than in the area of moral goodness.” Why do you think most people tend to be determined to make it on their own efforts?
4. Read Luke 10:25-28. Jesus presented obeying the Commandments as a plan for earning eternal life, but Paul in Galatians 3:23-25 says the Commandments had a different purpose. What was it? When & how did you come to see you couldn’t be righteous enough by your efforts at Command-keeping?

WORKS (25 minutes)
